AN UPDATE ON OUR NEW MAIL SERVER...

BY NOW YOU'VE PROBABLY HAD A CHANCE TO USE THE NEW AND IMPROVED PENTELEDATA WEBMAIL. IF YOU HAVE, THEN YOU ALREADY KNOW THAT THE NEW LOOK IS VERY SIMILAR TO MICROSOFT OUTLOOK, WITH A PERSONAL CALENDAR, AN OPTION TO USE A MOBILE VERSION, AND THE ABILITY TO CREATE RULES.

If you haven't seen it, then now is the time to try it out. Just visit webmail.ptd.net. Simply enter your email user name and password and you're set! While you're at home, on vacation or simply waiting for an important response, your e-mail will be ready. E-mails that you have already downloaded with a desktop client such as Outlook, Live or Macmail will not be included, but, as you'll see below, we recommend you using desktop clients and use our webmail from home, work, coffee shop or mobile phone moving forward.

Utilizing PenTeleData Webmail in place of other mail clients is beneficial in several ways. Here's why:

- Access from any computer with Internet and your folders, sent mail, contacts, and calendar will be synchronized.
- > All mail that is identified as Junk will automatically go into a Junk folder and is deleted after 30 days. In fact, we've recently changed our system so none of that junk mail is going to your Outlook, Live, MacMail or phone (if using POP). It only goes into Webmail. (With this in mind, remember to periodically check webmail's junk folder.)
- > Trash is automatically deleted after 30 days.

If you do need to continue using another mail client and/or if you have a smartphone that downloads mail, you should switch over to IMAP which will make your junk mail available and synchronize the mailboxes and folders for all computers. A Virtual Private Network (VPN) is a private data network using the public telecommunication infrastructure to privately share information between locations. It authenticates users and encrypts data to prevent unauthorized access to the information being transmitted.

Do You Keep Your Computer Protected?

Your computer probably stores some of your most confidential and important information, including financial records and family photos. Are you aware of how to keep your computer safe? Here are some important tips, and although you may have seen them here in the past, they are all worth repeating:

- > Use antivirus and anti-spyware software and keep it current.
- > Be careful about opening attachments or downloading files unless you know for certain what they contain.
- > Set-up automatic updates for your operating system software to be sure that it downloads and installs security patches as soon as they are available.
- > Use a firewall to protect your computer from hacking attacks while it is connected to the Internet.
- > Disconnect from the Internet when you're away from your computer.
- > Download free software only from sites you know and trust.
- If your computer has been hacked or infected by a virus, disconnect from the Internet right away. Then scan your entire computer with fully updated anti-virus and anti-spyware software. In addition, change any passwords that may have been compromised.
- > Use strong passwords and change them often. Though it's very tempting, reusing passwords is a security risk to your account and/or personal information.
- > If you use a wireless router, set a password to be sure that others are not sharing your network connection.
