Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network

Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network (GSRN), based in Allentown, Pennsylvania, is a nationally recognized rehabilitation leader, specializing in comprehensive post-acute care for people with physical and cognitive disabilities through state-of-the-art assistive and rehabilitation technology. More than 60,000 adults and children come to Good Shepherd annually for rehabilitation and supportive care after stroke, brain injury, spinal cord injury and amputation.

Good Shepherd's Allentown-based organization provides rehabilitation in eight eastern Pennsylvania counties at 22 outpatient sites, four inpatient sites, a long-term acute care hospital, two long-term care homes for people with severe disabilities, an independent living facility and Rehabilitation, a lifestyle products online store.

Good Shepherd was founded in 1908 when The Rev. John and Estella Raker invited a disabled orphan named Viola into their Allentown, Pennsylvania, home. Good Shepherd is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Founded in 2008, Good Shepherd Penn Partners, a partnership of Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network and Penn Medicine, provides post-acute care in the Philadelphia region.

PenTeleData provides data transport and networking services to GSRN, connecting their hub in Allentown to their sites throughout the region. More recently, we also began providing data service to their joint venture, Good Shepherd Penn Partners, and helped make a smooth transition into the Philadelphia market. PenTeleData helps GSRN get new sites in operation from a data/networking perspective and look ahead to anticipate their future needs based on patient care and growth.

Mike Cirba, Chief Information Officer at Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network, explained, "GSRN has been a PenTeleData customer for approximately seven years. We were looking for a consistent, stable solution that could connect all of our sites but could also give us the flexibility to upgrade and expand individual site service as we grew. An Update on the Progress of Our NextGen Network

Over the last year we've invested \$2.5million in a new DWDM transport network within the Lehigh Valley and have spent another \$2.5million this year to extend beyond the Valley. As of mid-August our Lehigh Valley system is now running on a 40-channel ROADM network which is an upgrade from a 4-channel passive system. The new transport network not only increases our core network capacity but allows us to now sell 10G transport between our nodes in the Lehigh Valley. We've called this our "Phase 1" deployment.

Further stages of deployment will include new core routers and continuing to build out the DWDM transport network north towards Wilkes-Barre, south to Ephrata and northeast towards Mount Pocono.



What is PenTeleData Webmail and How Can It Benefit You?

PenTeleData Webmail is available anytime, anywhere, from any PC or device with Internet access. While you are on vacation or simply waiting for an important response, your email will easily available.

It's easy – just visit www.ptd.net. On the right side of the page, choose "My Webmail". Click on the box and a new browser window will open. Simply enter your user name and password and you're set! Emails that you have opened from your email at home or work will not be included, so don't forget to close your email client while you're away. *(This can be changed in the Webmail account settings, but you will also need to configure your email client to use IMAP.)*

Utilizing PenTeleData Webmail in place of other mail clients is beneficial in several ways.

Here's why:

- > Access from any computer with Internet and your folders, sent mail, contacts, and calendar will be synchronized.
- > All mail that is identified as Junk will automatically go into a Junk folder and be deleted after 30 days. In fact, we've recently changed our system so none of that junk mail is going to your Outlook, Live, MacMail or phone (if using POP). It only goes into Webmail. *(With this in mind, remember to periodically check webmail's junk folder.)*
- > Trash is automatically deleted after 30 days.
- > At PenTeleData, we are very proactive about keeping our customers as safe from vulnerabilities. No provider can stop all malware and phishing attempts, but we definitely work behind the scenes to do as much as we can.
