If you enter your password in an external website and it's compromised, someone could try to sign in to your PenTeleData Account with the same information. This is also true for your other accounts, so it's important to choose unique passwords for each one.

Manheim is a charming small-town set in a rural landscape surrounded by sprawling countryside and rolling hills.

Founded in 1762 by Henry William Stiegel, Manheim was a safe haven during the Revolutionary War for the families of Colonial Patriots Robert Morris, the great Financier, Dr. Joseph Shippen, Surgeon General of the Continental Army, and General Richard Bache, the Colonial Postmaster General and husband of Benjamin Franklin's daughter.

Named after Mannheim, Germany and best known for Stiegel Glassworks, Manheim is steeped in colonial history, awash with a wide array of early American architecture and has become an artist and maker's haven.

Present day Manheim offers a mix of dining and retail options within walking distance. Just outside of town, you can tour a working dairy farm and climb a one-hundred-foot silo observation tower at Kreider Family Farms, enjoy award-winning PA wines at Waltz Vineyards Estate Winery & Tasting Room and experience a cast of costumed characters, craft beverages and delicious food at the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire. On Tuesdays, stop by Root's Country Market and Auction, the oldest single family-run country market in Lancaster County. Root's Market features a produce auction as well as fresh meats, bakery items, handmade crafts, antiques, and collectibles from over 200 stand holders.

Manheim is also home to Spooky Nook Sports, the largest indoor sports complex in the country, complete with rock climbing, an arcade, summer camps, and more.

Manheim has several art galleries, makers' experiences, cozy cafés, unique retail shops, and craft brewery and distillery restaurants, and well-appointed lodging options.
