Incorporated in 1815, Stroudsburg got its start as Fort Hamilton, one of a series of forts built by the Pennsylvania government. The town's location at the confluence of the Pocono, McMichaels, and Brodhead creeks made it suitable for gristmill and sawmill businesses. In 1836, Stroudsburg became the seat of the new Monroe County; it also became the county's leading market town. Lumber mills, tanneries, and textile mills contributed to the town's growth in the nineteenth century. Today, Stroudsburg's biggest industry is tourism.

Known for its proximity to the Poconos, Stroudsburg shines with a striking mix of historic allure and modern appeal. From shops to shows to seasonal festivals, its vibrant, walkable downtown has something for everyone. The town is home to museums and galleries, murals and music venues, wineries and restaurants. Stroudsburg has activities, art and flavors to please every palate. The birthplace of the J.J. Newberry department stores, the borough retains its beautiful, quintessential 19th century market town architecture, now housing exciting new shops and businesses to discover.
