"The support staff has been knowledgeable and helpful in all interactions. During an on-site visit to discuss the deployment of the DECT phone system, another PenTeleData Sales Engineer handled an exploratory question concerning the installation and provisioning of SPA modems to handle fax lines for some of our Kyocera TaskAlfa printers. Instead of referring to online documentation or scheduling another visit, he walked us through the steps, devices, and installation work required to implement the fax lines, and made sure to follow through with subsequent visits to ensure that our needs were being met.

"Due to the necessities of running an international logistics network, we were unable to shut down entire areas of certain departments to accommodate the installation of certain DECT antennas onto the support columns. Instead of limiting the installation time frame to off-hours, PenTeleData's I.T. Services team was able to work with us and work around us, establishing a reasonable time frame where we were able to work nearby the installation and provide accommodation for the equipment necessary to perform the installation."
