Historic Hotel Bethlehem

Historic Hotel Bethlehem is a luxury historic destination hotel where elegance meets authentic colonial charm. Located on the site of Bethlehem's First House and adjacent to the Moravian Church Settlements, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it proudly sits on the #1 Top Main Street in the U.S. and has been named the #1 Historic Hotel in the country by USA Today for five years in a row.

The Hotel Bethlehem was built in 1922 as a community hotel and remains the center of social life in Bethlehem and the Lehigh Valley. The 134 room/suite hotel has two ballrooms, two restaurants, 15,000 square feet of onsite meeting space plus 5,000 square feet in an offsite Executive Conference Center. In addition, it has three retail shops including "The Shoppe" Ladies Boutique, Hotel B Ice Cream Parlor, and Grandpa Joe's Candy Store. Steel Magnolia Spa/Salon opened above the Ice Cream Parlor in 2024 to round out the true Historic Destination experience.

Bruce Haines has been serving for 25 years as managing partner of Historic Hotel Bethlehem and was a co-founding partner. When asked why they chose PenTeleData to provide their Dedicated Internet Access, he shared, "We chose PenTeleData from the time we reopened the hotel in 1999 after the hotel had been bankrupt and closed for two years. PenTeleData's reputation as a Lehigh Valley stalwart business was the primary reason for the relationship."

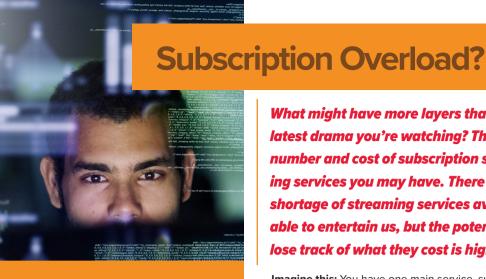
