First Commonwealth Federal **Credit Union**

First Commonwealth is the largest credit union in the Lehigh Valley, with over \$550 million in assets, nearly 50,000 members and six branches. They offer the same financial services found at a traditional bank, but with better rates and lower fees. That's because they're structured differently. They are memberowned and not-for-profit. Instead of earning money for stockholders, they return profits to their member-owners (account holders) in the form of higher dividends on savings, lower rates on loans and lower fees. First Commonwealth was originally chartered in 1959 to serve the employees of Western Electric in Allentown. Today, they serve nearly 700 employer groups - ranging from large corporations to very small businesses. Their full-service menu includes everything from checking accounts and debit cards to mortgages, online banking and bill pay.

When asked about why First Commonwealth has chosen PenTeleData to provide their data connections, Stephen P. Drosnock, Chief Technology Officer, explained, "PenTeleData is locally owned and operated. They have a reputation for reliability and great service. They were the only company who could provide a complete fiber network to all six of our locations across the Lehigh Valley. We replaced point to point T-1s with a fully meshed MPLS network. Their MPLS is our primary connection for our branch network. With this one implementation we more than doubled our bandwidth, built in redundancy, and added an Internet access point. PenTeleData's services reduced latency between branches and provided us with the ability to operate our hot site for disaster recovery without any issues."

At the time of this writing, First Commonwealth was planning some exciting changes to



begin this summer. An upgrade to their data processing system will allow them to better serve their customers, with fully integrated accounts and streamlined processes. The more advanced technology will help to serve their members quickly and efficiently with options such as mobile banking, redesigned statements, account alerts via text messaging, and a customized landing page for account log-in.

There's no doubt that with all of the services offered by First Commonwealth, they need a data provider with a history of being trustworthy. At PenTeleData, we strive for excellence in technology. It's our network that sets us apart. Mr. Drosnock shared, "PenTeleData's service has been very reliable. We have been very pleased with their performance in this area. We do not see errors on the networking we used to see on the T-1s. We always get the bandwidth we need and expect. The added bandwidth actually improved the performance of our applications, which in turn reduced support calls to us. In the rare instance when we have to report an issue, their Network Control Center was already aware of the problem and has always been able to give us a detailed status of the situation."

In both the financial and communications industries, use of new technologies is essential. It's a commitment that both First Commonwealth Federal Credit Union and PenTeleData share and a partnership that is almost certain to see continued growth and expansion in the years to come.

FLASHBACK JUST 25 YEARS AGO... IT'S ALL BECAUSE OF OUR FIBER!

Depending on your age, you may remember the 1980's—who had a cell phone and if you did it was the size of a football...who wanted to talk on the phone in their car anyway? Internet—what was that? What about over 200-300 digital cable channel choices? Video on Demand required a trip to the video store and high definition meant sitting on the floor a few feet in front of your television set.

Cable has come a long way, not only since the 1980s, but also from our humble beginnings in the late 1940's and at PenTeleData, we work hard to continue the pioneering traditions that began with John Walson of Service Electric and Claude Reinhard of Blue Ridge Communications. They were the first to place antennas atop the mountains to improve television reception and bring cable television to valley cities. Since then, there have been many advances in the telecommunications industry. PenTeleData and our partners have always been at the forefront of those emerging technologies.

The PenTeleData partnership began in 1994 with the purpose of providing affordable Broadband Internet access and with the vision of a network that could carry services for tomorrow, and strategically planned accordingly. This meant designing, building and implementing over 9,000 miles of fiber optic cabling that helps interconnect cell towers for today's largest providers, connects the largest area Health networks, allows for secure online banking plus hundreds of digital TV channels, high definition services including local news & sports programming, Video On Demand (VOD), Digital Video Recorder (DVR), Broadband Internet access up to 50 Plus Mbps, digital telephone and so much more!

That partnership continues today, and includes Service Electric Cable TV and Communications, Service Electric Cablevision, Service Electric Broadband Cable, Ironton Telephone and Blue Ridge Communications. Not only has the Internet become more than any of us could imagine, but as we mentioned so many other services have advanced as well. What will the next 25 years look like---stay tuned!



TECH TIP:

IF YOUR CABLE MODEM OR DSL SERVICE STOPS WORKING, SOMETIMES THE EASIEST FIX IS TO RESET THE MODEM!

It might save you some aggravation and a telephone call to us. Here's what to do:

- 1. Turn your computer off, disconnect the power from your router (if applicable), then disconnect the power from the back of the modem.
- 2. Wait approximately 2 minutes.
- 3. Reconnect the power to the back of the modem.
- 4. Your modem's LEDs should begin to flash as the modem connects. Within a few minutes the modem should be online.
- 5. After the modem is online, plug in the power to your router (if applicable), and then turn on your computer. After Windows has reached the desktop, try browsing several websites.
