

Hidden River Credit Union

Hidden River Credit Union was chartered in 1953 and is open to anyone who lives, works, worships, volunteers or attends school within Schuylkill County. They have \$140+ million in assets and serve over 16,000 members with three branch locations, including Pottsville. Orwigsburg, and Frackville, PA. Their philosophy is "People Helping People" and with a full line of loan products and deposit accounts, that's what they do each day.

When Hidden River CU opened their newest branch in Frackville, PA, they needed some form of connectivity to their main office in Pottsville, PA, Michael T, Walser, Vice President of Operations, explained, "To be honest, our connectivity options were limited. The credit union could have used T1 Lines but opted for a faster Dedicated Ethernet Fiber Line connection supplied by PenTeleData. The Dedicated Ethernet Fiber Line provides connectivity from the Frackville Branch to the Pottsville Branch (main office) for access to the Core and Phone System. With all the data traffic passed through the Dedicated Ethernet Fiber Line, we have not experienced any service degradation."

In addition to using their connection to administer loans and deposit accounts, Hidden River Credit Union offers their members E-Statements. Debit Cards, Mobile Access with Mobile Deposit and PayPal Transfer, Online Access, Audio Access and Bill



Going forward, the credit union will continue to expand electronic services, especially their Mobile Application. PenTeleData is proud to offer the services to support their goals. The PenTeleData partnership has invested more than \$300 million in fiber optic infrastructure with nearly 10,000 miles of fiber optic cabling that serves existing customers in all facets of life from their homes to business, including banking, healthcare, education, government, retail sales, and the wireless industry. Power Up Your Devices with Cable!

"More than a half-century ago, a single technology was developed and introduced in Pennsylvania that has provided entertainment, education and information for tens of millions of Americans.
